Information About PAG Member Tents

PAG encourages artists to "test-drive" the art festival experience to find out how festivals generally work and to help make a decision about whether it is something that looks good as a practice.

To that end, we offer 8 PAG Member tents. Each tent has 3 walls available to hang artwork. **Each wall costs the member \$75** for the 2 days of the festival.

For that price, the member receives:

1 10'x10' wall with hanging grid and hangars

Help setting up the tent and tearing down the tent, to include required corner weights.

Requirements:

To secure a wall in a shared tent, please apply for a member's tent. The non-refundable **cost to submit is \$35**. This includes sending in 3 images of your artwork. Please do not attempt to sell any item that is not of the same type as that submitted in your entry.

For example: Your images are watercolor paintings, but you also decide to sell handmade soaps, planter pots or decorated light switch covers. The last 3 items and their like are not permitted.

For example: Your submitted entries are photographs, but you also do oil paintings. Unless one of your entry images includes an oil painting, the oil paintings would not be permitted.

You must supply a credit card payment acceptance device if you intend to accept credit card payments. Most folks use Square. You must offer receipts for purchases. This occurs automatically in Square, but for cash sales, you will need to buy a receipt book.

If you have enjoyed the opportunity to sell from the Member's Tents in the past, you may not show there again.* This makes it possible for other members to get a chance to try out art festival showing.

Finally, if you are fortunate enough to reserve a space for yourself in the Members' Tents, you are required to attend both days of the festival.

*NOTE: If there are not enough requests for space in the Members' Tents, meaning not enough folks have registered by the deadline, then requests by members who have shown there in the past will be honored. There is however increased financial risk for previous users of the Members' Tents because you must pay a non-refundable fee(\$35) to apply to Art in the Park.
